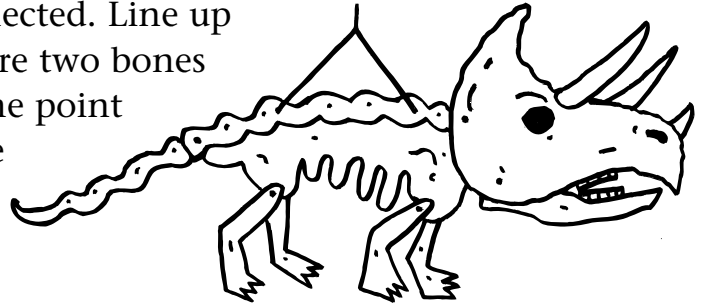


Dino Bones

You will need a pair of **scissors** and **five brass fasteners** to turn this pile of bones into a dino skeleton!

First cut out all the bones. Arrange the bones on a flat surface so that they make a full skeleton. The dark black dots show where the bones will be connected. Line up the black dots in each of the places where two bones connect. You can use a hole punch or the point of a fastener to make a hole through the black dots. Then use the fasteners to connect the bones—you'll have a dino skeleton to hang in your room!
