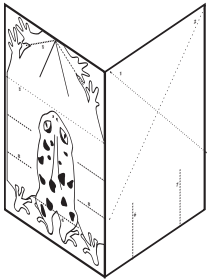
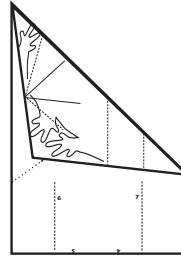


# Jumping Frog

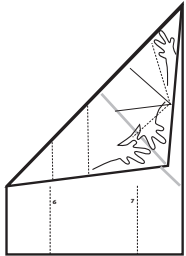
It's not hard to make this frog. Just remember to always fold in along the dashed lines (so you can't see them anymore). But only make creases along the dotted lines, by folding in first and then unfolding.



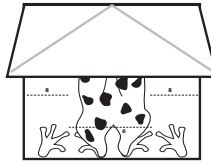
**1** Cut out the big rectangle and fold it in half along the solid black line so the printed sides of the paper show.



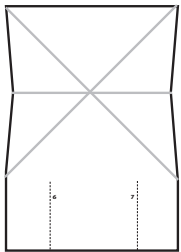
**2** Color the frog, then place the folded paper with the frog side down. Fold in along the dotted line 1 and then unfold.



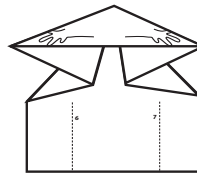
**3** Fold in along the dotted line 2 and then unfold.



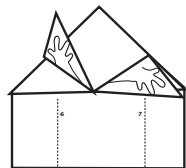
**4** Turn the paper over so the frog faces up. Fold in along the dotted line 3 and then unfold.



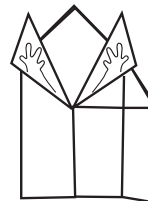
**5** Turn the paper back over.



**6** Gently collapse down along the creases you made in steps 2 through 4.



**7** Fold up along the dashed lines 4 and 5 (so the paper's edge touches the solid line).



**8** Fold in along the dashed lines 6 and 7. (The upper sections tuck under the folds you made in step 7.)



**9** Fold up along the dashed line 8.



**10** Fold down along the dashed line 9.



**11** To make your frog jump, push its back end down and quickly release your finger.
